Risk Level <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ORT: Opioid Risk Tool• DIRE: Diagnosis, Intractability, Risk, Efficacy• SOAPP: Screener & Opioid Assess for Pts w/ Pain	Visits (per year)	Urine Drug Testing <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pill Counts• PDMP (per year)
Low	4	2
Moderate	4	4
High	6	6

- States laws may mandate the level and frequency of monitoring
- Monitoring should be more intensive during the first 6 months of opioid therapy and after making dose adjustments including tapering
